Description of Programme:

The SSMS's IMR organized a Workshop on Research Methodology and Summer Internship Project Guidance on 30th November 2023 at 11.00 am. The Resource person was Dr. Rohan Dahiwale, Associate Professor **Rajgad Institute of Management**, **Research & Development** Dhankawdi, PUNE. The session was attended by the students of M.BA Part I and II and the MBA faculty. The Programme began with Asst. Prof. Dr. Nidhi A Medhekar introducing the resource person.

Dr. Rohan Dahiwale actively interacted with the students on the topic of 'Research Methodology'. He discussed the aims of conducting research, what research is and is not, the



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difference between methods and methodology, Research Process and Data Collection and Sampling. Research methods may be understood as all techniques used by the researchers during the course of studying the research problem. Research methodology involves various steps generally adopted by a researcher in studying the research problem along with the logic behind them. He also covered the Research Proposal, deductive and inductive approaches adopted in research. In Deductive reasoning thinking proceeds from general assumptions to specific applications, while Inductive reasoning is concluding about events (general) based on information generated through many individual and direct observations (specific).

The resource person also spoke about the components of a theory in research i.e. What, How and Why and the importance of boundary conditions i.e. Who, Where and When Then he went on to speak about the process involved in research in greater detail. The research process is as follows;

Formulating the research problem; Extensive literature survey; Developing the hypothesis; Preparing the research design; Determining sample design; Collecting the data; Execution of the project; Analysis of data; Hypothesis testing; Generalisations and interpretation, and Preparation of the report or presentation of the results.

The resource person stressed on the importance of review of literature i.e. why it is important, why a researcher should not stop and continue reviewing the existing literature till the time of data collection. He also gave his insights on how to review the existing literature in a particular area of research, how to identify the research problem and research gap, How to formulate hypotheses, the errors involved in accepting and rejecting hypotheses i.e. Type I and Type II errors etc. The resource person also focus on data analysis method and importance of proper data analysis techniques. During the session the resource person highlight the SIP Project guidance to student and given the standard method to write correct research report and briefly explain the various chapter involve in written research report. Dr. Rohan Dahiwale presentation concluded with an interactive session with the students. The Programme ended with a vote of thanks proposed by Dr. Vaishali Nikam, Asstt. Professor of MBA at SSMS's IMR. A total of 50 students participated in the event.



Objective of Programme:

- To provide the guidance regarding NEP 2020
- Workshop on Career Opportunities after 10th and 12th service, Engineering services, etc.
- To make students understand challenges in NEP 2020 implementation.
- To create awareness among students about NEP 2020 educational changes.

Description of Programme:

The IQAC of Institute of Management and Research, Pune organized a session on NEP 2020 Workshop: Career Opportunities after 10th and 12th on 2nd June 2024 at 4.00pm under Quality Improvement programme of SPPU. The institute received funding of Rs. 10,000/- under QIP scheme for oranising this workshop.

Considering the need of today's students to compete and face the challenges of the modern world, and to make them aware of the competitive examinations, the cell organized this talk to build among students a sense of NEP 2020 awareness, provide guidance, necessary sites, and other information about various competitive examinations. The session began by the deliverance of welcome address by the officiating director of th Institute **Dr. Prajakta Warale.** He congratulated the IQAC for taking the initiative to organize a session on such an t topic. He in her address emphasized on the need for preparation for competitive examinations to equip the

students for exploring employment opportunities. He also said such sessions for students are necessary to develop their competency in achieving their career goal.

The resource person Mahesh Shinde began the session by stating that today the students have lot of openings for prospective career in government sector, corporate sector, in leading public sector banks and even in the UPSC (Union Public Services Commission) and SSC (State Services Commission) where they can make a niche for themselves. The speaker chose to emphasize on the main components of competitive exam in the country namely the Union Public Service Commission. The speaker threw light on the Union Public Service Commission (UPSC) and stressed on the intricacies of it, such as the qualifications, number of attempts, reservations, cut-off marks and the total number of services which comes under it. He also elaborately discussed on the exam cycle which takes an entire year to complete. He made the inquisitive students learn how to apply for the exam and then enlightened them of the various sources to refer for preparation. He explained in detail the preliminary, mains and interview part of the examinations. He also threw a light on the selection, salary offered, age limit, reservations, duration for preparation and exact time to start for preparation. The resource person also briefly touched upon the Maharashtra Public Service Commission exams and updated them of the various topics and areas they should consider while preparing for this competitive exams. Further, he addressed the students as to how to prepare and study for such exams, what memory techniques can be used to remember the huge data, method of study, use of various websites which provide assistance for competitive exam aspirants. He stressed that rigorous training; systematic planning and hard work are the keys to face the entrance exams. Both UPSC and MPSC require a long-term commitment. Success in these exams hinges on consistent effort, understanding the syllabus in-depth, regular practice (especially for writing), and staying updated with current affairs. Patience and persistence are key, as is maintaining a positive mindset throughout the journey.

Prof. Lazri Gokhale, HOD (BBA) of IMCC and board of studies member of BBA, of Savitribai Phule pune university also shared her thoughts on NEP 2020, and opportunities for BBA students and its career opportunities.

The session concluded with vote of thanks by Dr.Nidhi Medhekar .
